

## **The environment of the report (the situation of human rights in the occupied Palestinian territories - the purpose of the report - the divisions of the report):**

During the year 2022, the crisis of the Palestinian political system continued, the absence of democracy, the disruption of elections, the dominance of the executive authority over the judiciary, the continued dissolution of the Legislative Council, the ineffectiveness of the institutions of liberation organizations, the continuation of the state of exclusivity and exclusion in the political system, and the absence of local and student elections in the Gaza Strip the executive authority encroached on rights and freedoms, especially in the wake of the murder of activist Nizar Banat in the West Bank, while the disastrous humanitarian situation in the sector remained the same. This exacerbated the human rights crisis in the Palestinian territories, which involves the weakness of human and peoples' rights guaranteed in international conventions.

The cessation of the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip, which lasted for three days and stopped in August 2022, revealed horrific scenes of Israeli crimes committed against Palestinian civilians in the Gaza Strip, where the Israeli military occupation forces deliberately and systematically targeted the debtors, and their civilian properties, especially residential homes located in densely populated neighborhoods, with the aim of killing children and women, displacing thousands of families, and causing severe material damage to the residential surroundings of these facilities.

According to the latest statistics issued by the Palestinian Ministry of Health, 56 people, including 19 children, were killed in the Israeli military attacks on the Gaza Strip, and hundreds were injured, In addition to widespread destruction of homes and infrastructure; In addition, the occupation authorities have continued to impose collective sanctions and restrictions on the Gaza Strip for about 16 years in a row, by closing the crossings and preventing the passage of goods and citizens, including the Palestinian patients, who prevented nearly 8,000 patients from traveling to receive the necessary treatment in hospitals outside the Gaza Strip.

The Israeli blockade and the subsequent punitive measures in the Gaza Strip aggravated the situation, making nearly a third of the Palestinian families in the Gaza Strip suffer from food insecurity, and raising the poverty rate, which reached 75%, of whom 34% are below the poverty line, and the unemployment rate in the Gaza Strip reached more than 56%, most of whom are young people, especially university graduates, with about 70% of them, and proportion of food insecure is over 80%, in addition, there are multiple crises related to electricity and drinkable water shortages, health and education sector crises and other critical sectors, as well as power outages for about 12 hours a day, which have a significant impact on various other critical sectors.

During 2022, field killings of 178 West Bank citizens escalated markedly during raids on villages, cities and camps in the West Bank and occupied Jerusalem, as well as on roadblocks.

During 2022, arbitrary arrests has wildly increased, thousands of civilians in the West Bank and approximately 107 civilians in the Gaza Strip, most of whom were detained at crossings around the occupation of detention points; the Israeli occupation forces continue to pursue oppressive policies against Palestinian detainees with a view to undermining their dignity, through a policy of physical and psychological torture and deliberate medical neglect in Israeli prisons and detention centers, which have claimed the lives of 333 Palestinian prisoners in detention in the Israeli prisons.

The year 2022 was the worst in settlement incursion in the cities of the West Bank and occupied Jerusalem, with data indicating a high rate of forced confiscation of land and property in favor of the implementation of settlement projects, including the expansion of settlement outposts, according to civil and international human rights organizations, 45% of the total area of the West Bank and occupied Jerusalem has been confiscated for a war crime described and completed in accordance with the established provisions of international humanitarian law, notably Geneva conventions in 1949.

During 2022,

escalated demolitions and destruction of buildings, and ordered the cessation of construction of hundreds of buildings; The Israeli occupation authorities demolish Palestinian homes

and put obstacles in the way of issuing construction permits to Palestinians.

To date, Palestine refugees continue to suffer a great deal, particularly in refugee camps in the Gaza Strip and Lebanon, Syria; To date, overall poverty rates remain at 76% among refugees in Lebanon. The unemployment rate among Palestinians in Lebanon, Gaza, Syria and Jordan has reached 56%. In contrast, the unemployment rate among Syrian Palestinians remains alarming, at 71.5%, and about 80% of the workforce among Lebanon's Palestinians are employed either as self-employed or as wage workers. Lebanon's main source of income was freelance work at 41%, followed by paid work at 37.8%, and UNRWA assistance through the social safety net program at 33.5%.

53.4% of workers (Syrian Palestinians) are paid daily, while the majority (97.7%) have only verbal agreements with their employers, allowing termination of employment at any time without prior notice. Moreover, 98.2% of workers do not receive sick or annual leave.

at the internal level; Despite the progress made within the framework of the Palestinian factions' agreement to the Algiers Declaration, 2022 saw the worst chapters of violations committed by Palestinian hands this year. Political and arbitrary arrests and summonses continued in the West Bank, as did the death penalty implementation in Gaza Strip.

The collective sanctions imposed by the Presidency and the Palestinian Government against the Gaza Strip, which have adversely affected and continue to affect the entire life and humanitarian system, in particular the health, education, electricity, water, the economy, trade, banks and other vital sectors, have continued; this was accompanied by continued violations by the West Bank and Gaza Strip executive authorities of a series of violations of citizens', journalists' and writers' rights to peaceful assembly, as well as taxation, particularly in the Gaza Strip, despite

conditions, all of which constitute a violation of Palestinian basic law and international instruments.

All these circumstances have made the international commission for the support of the Rights of the Palestinians to pursue its efforts and endeavor to ensure systematic intervention to guarantee the necessities of human life. It possesses experience and tools that qualify it to be one of the voices of victims of violations and their relatives, through its attempts to

contribute to the Palestinian citizen's exercise of his public rights and freedoms, it has intervened with government agencies to urge them to respect their elements of law and human rights. It has taken many positions on the violations committed and on the continuing consequences of the illegal situation of all authorities, especially after the expiration of the official term of the Palestinian Legislative Council and the President of the National Authority, municipalities and municipalities.

Through this report, the international commission for Support Palestinian rights seeks to provide detailed information on its various activities carried out during the time period between 1 January 2022 and 31 December 2022, in accordance with its operational plan, with a view correcting the course first, through an interim assessment that contributes to correcting the course and making it more responsive to the needs of subsequent developments in the Palestinian situation.

This report also aims to provide information to the future funding entities of the Authority for more accurate follow-up of the various activities of the Authority. which played a significant role, as the followers emphasize in considering the Commission as a timely and qualitative addition to complement the efforts of others in human rights organizations, Through an action strategy based on the idea of establishing international solidarity with the Palestinian people human rights ", focusing on peoples' rights, including human rights, and opening up broad space for Palestinian youth to be integrated into the human rights defending on Human Rights Group battle ", which serves the final analysis to achieve the idea of a human rights community, as a group of pressure and a clear influence on domestic and international legislation and policy on the rights of the Palestinian people.

Despite the challenges and difficulties associated with the spread of the coronavirus. compelling compliance with safety procedures to close the international commission's office more than once; However, since January 2022; "Operational Plan 2022" has been launched to ensure access to the International commission the plan to complete the course of work and to build on the results provided by the International Commission during its work in its third year, during which the International Commission (Hashd) survived and continued to accumulate expertise and interventions, some of which are qualitative and unprecedented, to consolidate its role as a

Palestinian institution that seeks to serve the rights of the Palestinian people and human beings. Indeed, in its second year, a Hashd has gone a long way in building the capacity of its Working Group, including by shifting their sights and interest in working professionally. It has also been an acceptable attraction for young women and men and has provided them with a suitable and successful environment, ensuring their effective engagement in the field of rights and law.

The report refers to the activities carried out by the international commission (Hashd) during the reporting period at the outset, we can confirm that the success of the Commission's implementation of approximately 95% of its activities set out in the operational plan for the first half of 2021 and the achievement of a high percentage of the objectives associated with this plan to achieve results contributed to the promotion of human rights in Gaza Strip. This provides further evidence of the institution's good strategic planning despite all the risks and the consonances from the private working environment in Gaza Strip.

The present report is divided into a series of segments, allocating space to each of the Commission's programs, to demonstrate the activities carried out during the period between 01 January 2022 and 31 December 2022; The report concludes by indicating the target groups of Hashd activities in Gaza Strip.

**During the report period (2022), the international commission (Hashd) worked hard to reach its planned outputs, implementing the following activities:**

1. Released 148 press releases, 78% of which dealt with and took a legal and human rights attitude towards Israeli violations and policies, 13% of which dealt with and took a legal and human rights attitude towards violations and policies of the Palestinian National Authority. The statements actually constituted the voices of the victims, occupying a considerable area of media and, in particular, written media and thousands of social media sites; Press releases contributed to exposing Israeli and Palestinian violations.
2. The commission followed up and participated in releasing of 13 statements of position signed by hundreds of Arab and international rights institutions about the events and violations of the occupation internal violations.
3. Published 183 press releases that contributed to the coverage of the activities of the international commission, making it an interest of the local, regional and international media.
4. Released 15 press reports; released by the commission's Board of Directors and Executive Staff; Many human rights issues and violations have been addressed in urgent situations.
5. The international commission organized 7 central press conferences that reviewed the overall human rights situation and the Israeli occupation crimes in Jerusalem and crimes of family destruction in occupation prisons and others; it called the international community and all parties related to assume their legal responsibilities towards the rights of Palestinians, particularly in Gaza Strip, who were in a disastrous situation that called for immediate intervention to halt the collapse and its repercussions.

6. The international commission crew and task force appeared approximately 215 times during the report period; Among them (89) times via TV; And (126) times across different local radio stations.
7. Hashd implemented 09 training programs; Aimed at improving and building the capacity of 172 young people, civil society workers, university students, lawyers and media professionals in the field of human rights advocacy; Distributors (85 female, 87 male).
8. Implementation of a long-term training (diploma) in the eighth installment of the eight-month Human Rights Researcher Program where (28) scholars and researchers from the graduates of this long-term program were graduated.
9. The Commission organized the Palestinian Cause Forum; With the participation of 530 participants in Gaza Strip and through Zoom program, which provided a real opportunity to meet with experts, specialists and interested people on human rights in Palestine from the Arab world and various countries of the world; It also provided a free space for exchanges of views and proposals that would narrow the scale of human rights violations and provide a comprehensive national vision on the international strategies required to protect Palestinian rights under regional and international variables.
10. Organizing a research competition on international protection in which 56 researchers participated. A jury was formed, which decided that three research discussions will win , a celebration and distribution of awards was organized with 170 participants and representatives from civil society and the media.
11. Launch of a new batch of the human rights researcher's program; The ninth installment of the program, which has come to consider Palestinian youth, especially university graduates, as an opportunity to enhance their capacity to belong more to the field of human rights, with the participation of 25 participants and youth graduates from Palestinian universities.
12. 48 international documents where developed; Circulated 25 rights and legal briefing notes, 23 international communications; Sent to 1,458 international and regional organizations and widely disseminated, with a view of providing international, regional and Arab bodies with information on the human rights situation. During the reporting period, the commission continued to employ these mechanisms by providing them with detailed and specific information on human rights violations in the occupied Palestinian territories.
13. From sharing information on human rights violations in the Occupied Palestinian Territory, in particular Gaza Strip, to the extent that it has gained the confidence of many international and regional organizations, where the commission has sent 20 international documents; 10 calls, 10 reports; These documents were sent to 7400 international and local organizations and personalities; (50%) of them relate to violations of occupation such as -field killing, conditions of prisoners and detainees, settlements, incursion into Al-Aqsa mosque, aggression against Gaza Strip and its various consequences, and the

Other (50%) relate to internal violations by official governing authorities in the West Bank and Gaza Strip of citizens' rights, particularly in relation to violations against the backdrop of opinion and expression, peaceful assembly, arbitrary arrest, violation of the rights of public officials, collective punishment, refraining from providing services, etc.

14. Developing and sending 18 special letters and memos sent to local government authorities in Gaza Strip and West Bank; The claim dealt with the release of citizens and

humanitarian conditions in Gaza Strip, the chaos in West Bank, political arrests, the denial of issuing passports, the refusal to implement judicial rulings, the infringement of rights and freedoms, the families of martyrs and the wounded, and the beneficiaries of social affairs, and about the services provided For citizens, mechanisms for addressing poverty and unemployment, stopping collective penalties, and redressing employees of Gaza Strip, especially those whose salaries were stopped, pensioners, unemployment workers, and the case of 2005, in addition to dealing with the issues of youth, children, women, and persons with disabilities.

15. The International commission (Hashd) implemented 25 workshops, with the participation of approximately 1,700 representatives of civil society, political parties, young people, about 40% of women and 60% of men. These workshops and meetings covered the most significant challenges of the human rights situation in the Palestinian territories. The headlines highlighted include: Elections, women's issues and political participation of young people, violations of Palestinian digital content, citizens' functional rights, student elections at universities, delays in the disbursement of social development allocations... etc.
16. The international commission has issued (57) specialized and qualitative papers between policies, reports, fact sheets and position papers. It has published 23 reports and research studies; distributed over 06 special reports; 17 research studies; 34 position, fact and policy papers; It published 26 fact sheets; and 08 position papers.
17. The commission maintained the implementation of the program of the Palestinian Children's Parliament. During the reporting period, the Authority organized 164 parliamentary meetings in schools in Gaza Strip in an effort to promote and protect children's rights and school democracy.
18. The commission received 70 complaints of violations, including 21 complains from employees whose salaries were suspended by the West bank government without legal justification or the ones were prevented from obtaining passports. 49 complaints of various violations in Gaza Strip were followed up by the commission with the relevant authorities.
19. The Commission's media platforms, particularly its Facebook page, continued to operate in a stable manner and contributed to exposing Israeli-Palestinian violations of human rights, publishing approximately 439 posts; The page interaction ratio was 68,470.
20. Posted (131) Post The content of which is designed either in video form or in info graphic; On the commission's Facebook page.
21. 17 local and youth initiatives were implemented within the Development Opportunities Bank; with the participation of approximately 500 young people who followed the implementation of the initiatives; as well as over 6,500 participants in various humanitarian and human rights activities and initiatives.

Extensive participation in civil society and government entities where members of the Group participated in about (184) Participation and in events and activities carried out by various community bodies, organizations and components, intersecting with the objectives of the international commission, bearing in mind that in many participants the

23. Organizing a central ceremony to honor youth personalities and teams in partnership with the Hope Imprint Medical Team in the presence of 450 representatives of civil society organizations, media professionals and youth activists in the khalig Hotel Hall.
24. The commission played essential role in the successful activities of the Palestinian People's Congress in Gaza, the Bank and the movement aimed at holding comprehensive elections for the government and rebuilding the PLO.
25. The International Commission (Hashd) has maintained its membership in the Arab Organization for Human Rights, the National Advisory Body and the Palestinian NGO Network; It has also built strong relationships with a number of local and international networks and organizations.
26. The International commission invested its relationship with members of the President and members of its Board of Directors to build partnerships with international bodies supporting the struggle of the Palestinian people in the Arab States, Latin America and Africa to generate the widest international condemnations of Israeli occupation crimes and expand international solidarity with the rights of the Palestinian people.
27. Networking and signing memorandums of understanding, the commission sought to promote integration and cooperation with others, The commission also opened its doors to various youth groups and provided them with a place to meet and carry out events, The International Commission signed memorandums of understanding with the Centre for the Protection of Human Rights and the Ministry of Prisoners, and continued to implement and follow up on the memorandums of understanding signed with NGOs and universities in Palestine and Lebanon rights ", in favor of the implementation of human rights activities and initiatives that involve actors and young people in support of the rights of the Palestinian people.
28. During the period covered by the report, I.C.S.P.R continued its meetings with governors in the Gaza Strip. A delegation from I.C.S.P.R met with representatives of several governors to follow up on human rights complaints and violations.
29. Organizing 37 meetings with international personalities, including ambassadors, international delegations and journalists, both at the commission's headquarter and through social communication sites, during which discussions were held on the situation of Palestinians' rights.
30. Work continued with local and international partners and the commission Ambassadors' Network to launch international and local lobbying and advocacy campaigns in support of human rights in Palestine.
31. 45 meetings and interviews involving ambassadors and the Special Envoy of the Secretary-General of the United Nations, The Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights, the Relief Agency, the European Union, special rapporteurs, the International Federation of Parliamentarians, members of international parliaments, the International Fact-Finding Committee and representatives of international institutions to familiarize them with the human rights and humanitarian situation in Gaza Strip.
32. Holding a series of meetings and interviews on social media with representatives of Arab and international bodies and institutions and international civil society organizations to

33. Receiving a number of international delegations and journalists working for international media agencies at the Commission's office and informing them of the human rights situation and the work of the Commission.
34. Follow-up on the international human rights agenda and organize human rights diplomatic support activities by ensuring that human rights actors, apart from digital and popular advocacy, are informed by members of the General Assembly, the Human Rights Council, parliamentary federations, human rights institutions, experts, professional and student unions and influential figures in the world to move towards upholding the rights of the Palestinian people other than launching campaigns to lift the blockade on Gaza Strip support for families and detainees, support for the work of the International Relief Agency and campaigns to support the democratic path, elections in Palestine and the protection of public rights and freedoms.
