- After a very competitive selection process, 16 powerful documentary projects were selected for program and 6 Nordic Producers were selected to participate at Close Up's 2019-2020 Co-Production Training Program!
- The Close-Up First Workshop was held successfully in Morocco in December 13th 19th 2020. It was a moving week for us at Close-Up, witnessing our vision to form a community of passionate filmmakers creating documentaries together was highly inspiring! Seeds of ideas are on their way to becoming extraordinary projects.







At the end of the First Workshop the mentors gave concrete assignments to each filmmaker to be delivered in preparations for the second Workshop.

- Our filmmakers worked intensely with their committed mentors and team to break through artistic challenges. The Nordic producers attended as observes and held one-on-one meetings with the MENA directors.
- They all attended a brilliant masterclass by Nicolas Philibert; as well as a case study on Co-Production by Moroccan filmmaker Hind Bensari and her Danish producer Vibeke Vogel.





International Collaborations

NORDISK PANORAMA

The Close-Up Executive Director was invited from September 21 -24 2019 to the Nordisk Panorama in Malmö, Sweden to meet with industry people and emerging producers/candidates for the Close-Up Program.

She presented the Close-Up Co-Production Initiative. It was a success as many of these emerging producers applied to the program.



Accomplishments

- In the past 14 years our organization was one of the most prominent venture in the international documentary film world.
- In 14 years of activity, we have trained over 225 filmmakers from the Middle East, North Africa & Europe, guiding them to develop the necessary skills to create extraordinary and powerful films. The core elements of our work have proven to be a winning combination, and the results speak for themselves: Of 158 film concepts subjected to the full training program, 44 films have been completed, 3 films per a year. One film was nominated for Best Documentary at the American Academy Awards and won an International Emmy Award, many others won highly acclaimed international awards, and 50% of our graduates are in advanced stages of production. This is an extraordinarily high completion rate for a documentary development program, and a reflection of our enormous investment in ensuring that our films get made and funded.
