ORGANIZATIONAL PROFILE

Background of Tafaol Association:

All what Tafaol Association does is based on the slogan that all people of all colors, religions and nationalities have the right to grow up in good health, educated and safe.

Tafaol Association is a civil society organization that was initially established as a spontaneous initiative in 2017 from a group of ambitious and promising youth to a better and more developed society at all levels. Tafaol is considered as a part of the society.

Tafaol Association believes that humanitarian work and civic work must always strive to achieve social justice, and therefore it aims to work with individuals and societies through comprehensive interventions towards a society based on democracy, pluralism, citizenship values, and human rights.

Principles of the Establishment:

The scale of the crises in Lebanon has increased dramatically in recent years. Lebanese people are living in the struggle of poverty now than ever before, as well as more refugees. The disease nowadays is not only more frequent, but also more severe. Families in crisis are among the most vulnerable.

Tafaool Association has contributed to the method of providing health care in areas far from hospitals, which contain a high percentage of low-income families, and we can also say without income, through the establishment of semi-free medical centers and well-studied prices so that they fit the economic conditions of the Lebanese and Syrian population, so that They receive life-saving care before it's too late.



As the coronavirus pandemic has spread to almost every country in the world, the poorest and most disadvantaged families are hurt the hardest. Tafaol is working around the clock to ensure that the health and well-being of people are protected.



Also, for poor children, a good education is the key to changing their lives and their futures. It can mean they have access to better jobs, lead richer lives and fulfill their potential. A child's right to an education does not end in times of emergency. That's why we're focused on return to education, helping more children in crisis recover and return to learning than any other global humanitarian organization.

If all students left school with basic reading skills, 171 million people could be lifted out of poverty.

Objectives of the Establishment

Tafaol works hardly to achieve the following goals:

- 1-Intensive work to improve and advance the educational level through coordination and follow-up with Official and Private schools and the Ministry of Education.
- 2-Work to improve the health situation and coordinate with hospitals, doctors, and the Ministry of Health to cover the people who seek help.



3- Working on the file of people who do not have a Lebanese identity from the tribes who make up a large number by working with the legal and judicial committees in coordination with the Ministry of Interior and trying to deal with this file in an appropriate manner.

4-Create an environment protected by national belonging and guarded by civil law, away from tribal tribalism and a threat for young people of exotic ideas, suspicious curricula and takfiri projects.

5-Find bridges of communication and cohesion between the clan societies, each other, and all societies. The other is consolidating coexistence and national unity.

6-Finding meaningful flags that guide youth and preserve the original Arab principles and values and give the right image of the clans and their national history.

7-Building sports clubs and working on establishing sports teams in various activities.

8-Work to find special centers for the handicapped and those with special needs and establish orphanages and the homeless.

9-Helping widows and divorced women by finding a fund based on their needs and ensuring a decent life for them.



ACTIVITIES OF TAF AOL

Health -Mashael Medical Centers:

In comply with Tafaol Goals related to medical field, Tafaool had created **three** medical Centers (Mashael Medical Centers) to help poor people on medical domain in different areas in Bekaa governorate.

1-First Medical center was launched in January 2018 in Omariya - Zahle region Middle Bekaa.

2-Second Medical center was launched in June 2019 in Qab Elias region Middle Bekaa.

3-Third Medical center was launched in Hawech Al Harimeh– West Bekaa

These centers contains: Public Health Clinics, Dental Clinics, Women and Obstetrics Clinics and Physical Therapy Clinics.

1- **Public Health Clinics:** The services that provided on these clinics public health diseases, children diseases, Dermatology, Cardiology.

2- **Dental Clinics:** Provided all dental cases.

3- **Women and Obstetrics Clinics:** Obstetrics & Gynecology.

4-**Physical Therapy Clinics:** All Physical Therapy services.

Mashael Medical Centers set up by "Tafaool" seeking to serve Lebanese and Palestinian citizens and Syrian refugees without any discrimination in medical treatment and reduce human suffering. And try to cover all vulnerable groups.

Masha'el Medical Centers are considered the most medical centers on Bekaa attractive to people since the location of this medical centers covered Lebanese and Palestinian Citizens and Syrian refugees, in addition it provides most medical services.



Education -MayField Educational Center:

Tafaol Association conducted a 12-month educational program in the Western Bekaa region of Lebanon targeting Syrian refugees and Lebanese host communities.

The Education Program for Syrian Refugees and Host Communities in Lebanon (MAY FIELD) aims to provide assistance in the educational field to improve the educational level. Increasing the numbers of affected and vulnerable Syrian learners from the host communities in Lebanon by providing material support for the project, which was launched by the Tafaol Association two years ago. This project achieved great success in the past two years as the center's activity was continuing. We have conducted many training courses in some fields, accounting courses, computer courses, professional courses in addition to literacy courses, in addition to that we do many training courses and courses on hygiene about COVID_19 on life skills that this center has not stopped working on in the past two years. We aspire to establish similar centers in multiple regions in the Bekaa region.

Aim of this education project:

- Focus on obtaining equal and quality education for children who are unable to attend school due to difficult living and economic situations.

- Provide scholarship to students who are in need of assistance in respect of payment of school fees, books, project equipment, school uniform, transport, examination fees and subsistence allowance in accordance with conditions and qualifications the Foundation may from time to time impose.

- Open schools and training centers almost free of charge for all ages, nationalities and religions in order to reduce the specter of illiteracy and limit its spread.

The main goals of May Field Education Center:

- ❖ Enable Syrian refugees to obtain the right to education in the most advanced and developed way we have.

- ❖ To raise and improve the educational level in the region and increase the number of educated people.



- ❖ Help the youth and new graduates students in engaging in the labor market by vocational trainings.
- ❖ Give support to students that have problems on study by teaching agenda program.
- ❖ Make awareness session for all people on several domain (Human Rights, Hygiene, PSS, GPV, etc...).

Protection (Haqq Center for Legal Studies):

Tafaol Association always seeks to secure a decent life for all people, by defending human rights and helping people to reach all their rights, so we have established the Haqq Center for Legal Studies. We defend the rights of people and work to protect the most vulnerable among them, especially children and women. Our protection services include legal aid, advising and assistance in all matters of life, and expanding access to land, property, and individual rights. We strive to prevent sexual and gender-based violence in all its forms. We raise awareness about how to access rights. And one of the most prominent projects carried out by the Haqq Center is the subject of withheld registration, as this project has achieved great success by securing identities for many people, and we are still seeking to secure all rights for these people.

The Statistical Center of Tafaol Association (“Sheab-Stat”) was established to provide a common official database for all Tafaool centers. With the aim of achieving a high level of coordination between the associations projects in particular and between many local and international NGOs in general in the humanitarian, social, service and developmental fields. As you know, any project that is intended to be implemented needs to carry out intensive studies and statistics before implementation, so the Sheab center had a major role in conducting pre-surveying of places that are in need for development and development projects and submitting these statistics to Tafaool Association and to the parties concerned with helping people. Also it make many economic, social and cultural studies, which many universities and institutes have benefited from this studies.

PROGRAMS/ AREAS OF WORK

For 3 years, we are giving people in Bekaa a healthy start in life and protecting them from harm. When crisis strikes, we are always among the first to respond and the last to leave. We do whatever it takes to save people, change their lives and the future we share.

In a short period of time, Tafaool helped hundreds of people by providing health care and opening 3 medical centers in different cities. We did not choose the places previously mentioned in a random way, but rather these centers were established in geographical areas containing the highest proportions of displaced Syrians and Palestinians. Lebanese neighborhoods lack of medical services.

Tafaool focuses on obtaining a good and fair education for children who are unable to go to school due to the difficult living and economic conditions. Therefore, we conducted a serious study to establish educational centers, so the areas where the percentage of uneducated children were very high were chosen.

Poverty is a severe and persistent constraint that shapes the way children live, learn and grow. Millions of children around the world lose their childhoods as a result of poverty. Poverty deprives them of the capacities needed to survive, develop and thrive. They are more likely to suffer from malnutrition, disease, less likely to complete their studies, and more vulnerable to exploitation, abuse, violence and discrimination, so we are always keen to be always present next to these people and provide them with the necessary support without discrimination.



WHY THESE PLACES?

Location of Mashaal Medical Centers:

Tafaool Medical Center is located in different places (Hawsh Al Harimeh, Qab Elias and Omariyah), so that all western and central bekaa villages benefit from its services. As you know, that central Bekaa contains more than 200 refugee camps and west bekaa more than 150 refugee camps this shelters, as it contains more than 100000 Syrian refugees, distributed in the areas near to Tafaool Medical Centers. In addition, the area has a population of about 78000 people, Lebanese Palestinians, in addition to the Arab tribes. As most of them don't have Lebanese identity, 90% of the people in Central Bekaa and West Bekaa do not have access to hospitals and medical centers. So Tafaool association opens its medical centers in central bekaa in order to let all the people have a health care.

Location of MayField Educational Center:

May Field center is located at Khyara West Bekaa, main road, near the Lebanese International University.

Why this location?

Firstly, the western Bekaa region in general, contains a very large percentage of Syrian refugees and poor Lebanese families in addition to a large number of Palestinians. Secondly, the location of the center near the Lebanese international university and many educational centers such as Omar Al-Mukhtar School also the Technical Institute, contributes to attracting a large number of students due to the ease of access to the center.

Monitoring and Evaluation Plan:

The Monitoring: Evaluation and Learning (MEL) processes in Tafaool is used to guide programmatic decision-making and ensure that the program the intervention responds to the needs of the beneficiaries in a context-relevant manner. During startup, Tafaool panel members will review and, as needed, improve Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) the plan is presented as part of this proposal to ensure that the data collection plans are realistic, relevant and it can be performed at the required quality level. To the extent possible, the team will strive to collect both qualitative and quantitative data to provide a multi-layered view of the program's progress responding to the needs of the beneficiaries. The data collection process will be planned and implemented. Which not only engages heads of information systems, but also ensures the voices of men and women, Hear the voices of boys, girls and people deprived of the right to education. The team will benefit from digital data collection to simplify data collection, entry and cleaning processes, and to emphasize rapid visualization and participatory analysis to provide evidence to program and management teams empowering data-informed decisions. A comprehensive survey will be conducted to establish education center for the intended beneficiaries and allowed software for tracking achievements against indicators as well as capturing changes in knowledge and attitudes and practices. An internal midterm review after the first year followed by a lessons-learned exercise completion of project activities will provide the main lessons learned for evaluating program performance

Accountability to Affected Populations:

Adopt Tafaool a staggered approach to ensure any comments and complaints Submitted by beneficiaries shared during monitoring activities are highlighted to appropriate team members. The program team prepares monthly progress reports - including status updates at implementation, beneficiary access and challenges - fueled by monthly progress review meetings attended by staff from the Program, MEL, and Operations. This saves regular opportunity for the program team and senior management team to discuss how the challenges are.

**Coordination:**

Tafaool will maintain contact with the relevant national and sub-national authorities, sector working groups, UN agencies, NGOs, and community groups are involved in targeting identified vulnerable groups, secure access to affected populations and timely coordination responses. Tafaool maintains excellent relationships with municipalities and local governments, security authorities, executive departments and all humanitarian agencies operating in the Bekaa.

Management and Past Performance:

Tafaool has been working in the humanitarian field since 2017 presenting a range of humanitarian and development programs. Tafaool currently has medical centers, education centers, Haqq Center and Sheab center.

Tafaool continues to play a leading role in coordination efforts, as well as promoting the strategy and simplification.

Approach, including emergency contributions. Tafaool has many years of experience on implementing multi-sectoral and integrated programs in the fields of health, education and livelihoods. Through the establishment of medical centers and schools, rapid intervention in emergency situations.
