Terzo Millennio - Laboratorio di Umana Solidarietà is a Social Promotion Association founded in June 2013 by a group of professionals convinced that every person has the right to live with dignity and beauty.

Our Mission

APS Terzo Millennio - Laboratorio di Umana Solidarietà acts to promote, locally as well as globally, social participation and lifelong learning as tools for human and professional development, particularly of the younger generations. It strives to build sustainable development processes based on peace, respect for human rights, democracy and dialogue between different cultures and religions. It combats all forms of racism, discrimination, xenophobia and social exclusion, through practices of solidarity, cooperation, sustainable development, environmental protection and active citizenship.

The founding values of the association's action are:

- the constitutional precepts of peace, solidarity and anti-fascism;
- the need to rebalance the huge gaps in wealth and resources that separate the poor and rich parts of the world; and
- the right of all citizens to animate processes of sustainable social, economic and cultural development;

Description: "I viaggi nella bottiglia" is an interactive intervention aimed at promoting intercultural relations as an educational - training tool. Growth is first and foremost a subjective and relational experience, and school and family are two primary and fundamental agencies in this process. Just as the "Bottle" contains a message from elsewhere, so the Project aims to contain experiences far and

near. The "Journeys in the Bottle" collects each person's subjective experience and contains it, enabling them to embark on a journey of knowledge of the Other and connect with it, in order to build a new experience.

The general objective of the project is to promote the wellbeing and harmonious growth of minors, to develop and foster effective educational opportunities and to prevent social hardship and educational poverty. The actions put in place allow the cognitive and non-cognitive skills of minors to be strengthened through the enhancement of non-formal learning methods and the activation of integrative services in and out of school.

The activities, implemented at the "Casa Comune" Proximity Centre, are structured to allow the re-acquisition of personal and relational skills, contributing to the creation of a new model of social inclusion which, through ad hoc accompaniment paths, will foster the emergence and acquisition of the strategic competences or soft skills necessary to approach the labour market.

Description: "Football without borders" aims to raise awareness among the younger generations on the issues of racism and non-discrimination and intends to support social inclusion and the overcoming of stereotypes and prejudices through sport, in particular through football as a tool of cohesion, active participation and youth involvement. The project stems from the need that has emerged in the reference contexts of the associations involved to educate young people to adopt opinions, attitudes and behaviour that lead them to respect themselves and others, in all circumstances and conditions, regardless of any distinction based on sex, race, religion or other factors of diversity. The project consists of two phases:

The first phase carried out from 12 to 14 May 2023 included a meeting, held in Lecce, between the heads of the organisations involved, in order to define a common strategy for the inclusion of young people taking part in the activities, structure the youth exchange programme and establish the tools for managing and coordinating the project actions

The second phase saw the implementation from 18 to 25 June of the youth exchange. Twenty-eight

young people from Spain, Finland, Italy and France met and worked together on the topics of racism and non-discrimination, carrying out an anti-racist awareness-raising tournament.

Held on 25 February, the event involved a number of local and international organisations, representatives of institutions, academics, journalists and citizens who, in a sharing space, guided by expert facilitators, through Open Space techniques, were called upon to elaborate a "handbook" of good practices on migration to be implemented in our territory, also in the light of experiences already carried out in other contexts and to promote a sense of individual and collective responsibility on the theme of Migration, Welcoming and Social Inclusion.

Description: The third transnational meeting envisaged by the Eu Border Community project, financed by the European Union in the framework of the Europe for Citizens programme, was held in Spain. In this seminar, in particular, issues concerning strategies for the social and labour inclusion of refugees were discussed, with a specific focus on the experience of APS Terzo Millennio in Italy.

The festival included co-managed pedagogical activation days with the students (18-21 December), which ended on 23 December with an OPEN DAY at the Banzi high school in Lecce, during which, among other things, the course on Education with and for Human Rights was introduced for teachers and curated by Terzo Millennio.

9 November 2019

Terzo Millennio, together with Progetto Civitas, Artetèca and LCP, organised the Lecce premiere screening of the docufilm EL PEPE, UNA VIDA SUPREMA, the biography of former Uruguayan President Mujica directed by Emir Kusturica. The event represented the official launch of the first edition of 'Umana solidarietà', an independent human rights festival.

- ***Notte Verde: Agriculture & Sviluppo Sostenibile (Green Night: Agriculture & Sustainable Development)***

August 2019

Description: Terzo Millennio, as a partner, contributed to the realisation of the 2019 edition of the Green Night, an event that has become a must for all those who care about the sustainability of their territory, organised by the Casa delle Agriculture Tullia e Gino Association in Castiglione d'Otranto (LE). Terzo Millennio was the protagonist of the seminar 'Land, exploitation, redemption', an interesting dialogue between Andrea Pignataro, president of Terzo Millennio, Rosa Vaglio (Rights in the South) and Alessandra Pomarico (Free Home University), on the combination of their land, the exploitation of resources and human beings and the redemption policies that non-profit organisations can put in place.

Description: Thanks to its own experience on the theme of immigration and reception, Terzo Millennio was involved by the Italian partnership in the realisation of Eu Border Community, a transnational project supported by the European Union in the framework of the Europe for Citizens programme and involving local authorities and civil society organisations from six border countries to share experiences and practices on the theme of refugee reception. The association provided consultancy in the design and planning of the training course.
