## I. INTRODUCTION

The current situation of globalization is contributing to the fact that human migration phenomena, which have always existed, in this day and age have more complex characteristics, and that they bring about deep social and political repercussions in the States that are affected by these migratory fluxes.

The importance of the issues related to migrations is recognised by multiple international organisms: if these issues are not dealt with accordingly, social peace will not be possible on a mid/term basis. These problems require special attention in Spain, due to the lack of experiences and traditions related to the acceptance of immigrants among the population.

# 2. WHO WE ARE

The **University Institute of Studies on Migrations, IUEM** (Instituto Universitario de Estudios sobre Migraciones, **IUEM**) of Comillas Pontifical University was born in 1994 in this context and with the aim of giving an answer from the University. It has broadened its compromise with the area of Migrations, also linking it to development by adapting to the new international context.



3. WHAT WE DO



The **IUEM** is dedicated to research activities and assessment in the field of migrations and human mobility; to teaching, through three postgraduate programs; and the diffusion and divulgation of research results via courses, symposiums, congresses and the publication of *Migraciones* magazine, very well valued in different catalogues on impact indexes.

### 3.1. Research

The approximately 100 studies that have been developed up to now have positioned the IUEM as a reference centre in Spain regarding the fields of international migrations and human mobility <u>http://www.comillas.edu/en/research/migration</u>.

One of the major research lines in the **IUEM** has to do with **the follow/up of the trajectories and integration processes of immigrants in the recipient society.** In this sense, we study the different areas in which integration will take place (workplace, household, education, neighbourhood relationships, access to different services and provisions...) either for immigrant population in general or for the most representative groups, always under the scope of the legal environment of Spanish and Community immigration and asylum policies.

# The Ibero/American Observatory on Human Mobility, Migration and Development (OBIMID)

It driven and coordinated by the IUEM network, brings together various institutions in Latin America, Caribbean, Portugal and Spain, linked to research on human mobility, migration and development Latin America,

His first publication "Migration in the borders of Latin America" is a "transversal and comprehensive" study that aims to be the first of a series of research publications made in this matter.

#### > Chair in Forced Migrants and Refugees

The Chair in Forced Migrants and Refugees supported and sponsored by INDITEX forms part of the University Institute of Studies on Migration (IUEM) of the Comillas Pontifical University.

Forced migrants and refugees are one of the collectives that best represent the gaps and opportunities in the new global setting. The Chair, in line with the Comillas Pontifical University, was established with the idea of discovering and responding to said reality from its specific academic stance, while maintaining permanent contact with the social agents that work in this field.

The interdisciplinary aims of the project are to undertake theoretical and applied research on the issue in question, the development of collaboration and joint work between social organizations and agents that work with forced migrants and refugees, specialized training and, finally, social awareness and communication, particularly within the university setting. The scope of the project is national, European and international.

Six volumes have been published to date.

- Since 2008, the different publications of the IUEM are unified (Sociedad, Cultura y Migraciones y Documentos Prácticos del IUEM) under the new collection "Migraciones y sociedad" (Migrations and Society). The first title is No one should loose: immigrant's children on their way to adulthood (Nadie debe perder: hijos de inmigrantes en su camino a la vida adulta).

Editing the *Migraciones* journal is, without any doubt one of the most important achievements of the IUEM regarding publications. *Migraciones* is the first journal specialised in research that is edited in Spain concerning this topic. It started out in 1996 and has been published continuously each semester since then.
