MAC CLUB leadership working space M.A.C.L.W partnership with the U.S. Consulate general Alexandria (2018)

Youth are the main asset that drives the engine of productivity in the society today and tomorrow. Therefore allowing them to be empowered personally and professionally would be a corner stone towards better community status.

In a 4 days training programme, 40 participants were empowered on the leadership and capacity building level through inquiry based approach and integrative methodology.

Participants acquired facilitation and presentation skills according to fundamental techniques on Project management, awareness raising campaigns and event planning.

In addition, participants got a certification as aspire community leaders, as they will be working as community coordinators with a social development organization.

Training Structure was a Series of training sessions based on the non-formal education approach and peer-to- peer education. Case studies and thematic group discussion that will stimulate in- depth participatory reflections as well as group working and experiential learning activities with a view of strengthening competencies in the field of civic education and participation.

The training and its approach focusses on using individual and structural human resources as agents of change and professionalization.

EconoWin Program (Economic Integration of Women in the MENA Region) – giz (2017)

Training on using the gender tools and women economic empowerment on using the ANA HUNNA educational-kit for universities and TVET teacher in order to apply this in the methodology of their educational contents.





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Project Management and Marketing for promoting female leadership in Gh'et El Enaab (2016)

Project by Sekka organization in partnership with Alexandria Arts Centre and Sawiras Foundation were we used to allow the females in Gh'et El Enaab Area in Alexandria to know what does the word Project Management mean, how we design a project, how could we sustain it and implement it and finally how to market for their products.

Local Integration Activities with UNHCR and Caritas Egypt (2015 – 2016)

Cultural and integrative program for the children refugees using capacity building, cultural tools and arts on order to allow them to be able to integrate in the community and allow them to identify their skills and potentials as well.

The program was designed for the Syrians in Borg El Arab and in later stage in El Agami and El Ras El Soda.

EconoWin Program (Economic Integration of Women in the MENA Region) – giz (2016) Work for Women is the gear of life Training programme (training took place in clothing factory)

Phase 1:

Training was conducted to 30 participants from the locals in Egypt (mainly civil workers with age sector 20s to 30s) , this age mainly because of the integration of all factors of success in learning process additionally this sector majors 60 % of our community , they're active with a massive capability to empower their advocacy skills and achieve the demanded results for a specific cause.

Phase 2:

The training also included Outdoor sessions in work places specially the places which includes cases of a successful women who tried hard to get a proper employment like a factory , office , restaurant etc Sequentially it has to be video graphed for documentation to be posted online

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Integration revolution training for Elnasr school EGC& EBS training (2014)

The training was conducted for young students attending high school to integrate with the civil community and to learn how to volunteer efficiently in the community activities, moreover how they can participate in the community service applications in Egypt. The training included basic and advanced skills with interactive workshops.

MUP training with the Foreign and commonwealth office (2014)

The model of United Kingdom parliament is a simulative training for undergraduates and fresh graduates. The project at the first place is inspired by the UK youth parliament experience in the British community which gives a great opportunity to the participants in the project to represent the two houses in the parliament (LORDS AND MPS) in a final conference discussing several domestic and foreign issues concerning the UK after 2 month training and be part of several sessions to know the procedures and suitable academic content. The main purpose of this project is to introduce the basic skills of presentation and communication aspects to enhance their enthusiasm for developing their career with innovative methodologies of facilitation.

Capacity Building full training (2012 – 2013)

Conducted in several faculties under the umbrella of Alexandria University. This training was a full frame training which included all skills needed by the university undergraduates to integrate in the labour market demand, Moreover the added value for the students to have a proper career plan.
